



Dear Music Educators,

White House of Music’s “Lease to Learn” instrument rental program offers two plans: monthly and annual rentals. The “end of the school year” is not the end of their rental plan with us at the White House of Music. UNLESS the customer communicates to us that they plan to be done with the instrument and do not plan to continue in music programs next year. Otherwise, all rental instruments should be brought home to keep playing music throughout the summer!

Monthly Rentals have no expiration date; customers keep renting monthly as long as they choose.

Annual Rentals expire a year from the month they first rented (it could be August or September). The annual customers chose the “Pre-Pay and Save” option for the 12-month duration. Their agreement will continue monthly after the first year. Unless they decide to “Pre-Pay and Save” again.

In discussions with Music Educators, we heard universal support for any effort to keep students playing over the summer.
